Artificial Intelligence (AI) is an exciting new technology that can be used as a valuable tool for natural resource management programs.

This workshop will give a clear understanding of how to use AI effectively in Caring for Country programs through easy-to-follow demonstrations and activities using no code, intuitive tools. It will include an overview of AI applications and present easy to use programs for (1) image recognition, (2) AI assistants for video production and graphic design, and (3) Voice to Text tools associated with Large Language Models (LLMs: Chat GPT, Gemini, etc.). Participants will learn about these tools and how these tools can help with everyday tasks such as: creating videos, posters, writing reports and applying for grants.

We will also talk about the problems with AI, such as hallucinations, giving answers that are not applied to our region, being biased, and concerns about data privacy.

Participants are encouraged to bring their own laptop. Participants without a laptop are still welcome, some spare laptops will be available.
